North Lake High Water No Wake Procedures

High Water Marker

This is placed at Jim Schneider's residence. The North Lake Management District will notify the Town of Merton and Village of Chenequa's Clerk office of the decision to post if the water level exceeds 897.0 msl. The Town of Merton will then place signs indicating a High Water Condition at the North Lake Yacht Club and Oconomowoc River launch site. In the future, other public launch sites will be posted.

The signs will have both the Town of Merton Ordinance and Village of Chenequa Ordinance listed. The North Lake Management District does endorse the ability of the Town Highway Superintendent to enact the High Water Level in accordance with Ordinance 20.04.

The North Lake Management District will notify members of their Association via email or other communiqués. In addition, the North Lake Management District will place a buoy in the lake at their discretion.

Beaver Lake High Water No Wake Procedures

High Water Marker

This is located in a boathouse at 31128 West Thompson Lane. The Village of Chenequa makes the determination if the level exceeds 910.2 msl. In the event that water levels exceed this level, the Village of Chenequa will contact the Town of Merton and inform them.

The Village of Chenequa will take care of placing signs at the Beaver Lake Yacht Club and Hwy 83 public access for the Village of Chenequa. The signs will have both the Town of Merton Ordinance and Village of Chenequa Ordinance listed.
